- Riesling, Hexamer, Porphy, Nahe, Germany 2016 52
An off-dry style that lies nicely in between Riesling's vibrant acidity and its wonderful minerality
- Fiano, Lunate, Casa Vinicola Botter, Sicily, Italy 2021 30
A wine of notable depth that displays pretty notes of orchard fruit, yellow plums and honeysuckle
- Chenin blend, Oldenburg Vineyards 'CL' Stellenbosch, South Africa 2020 45
Chenin blanc adds a bit of flowery and peachy freshness while the chardonnay and its subtle oak ageing rounds it off with a tinge of toast

Light, crunchy red fruits with a mouth watering acidity. This Gamay is a perfect alternative to Pinot Noir
- Montepulciano d'Abruzzo, Fratelli Barba, Italy 2020 32
This is just such a quaffable bottle with its plump core of plums, black cherries and spice

PINOT NOIR

Domaine du Grand Tinel, Châteauneuf du Pape, Rhône, France 2017	98
<i>A nose of blackberry compote, cherry and spice is followed up with an expansive, and concentrated palate.</i>	
Grenache Blend, Chateau de Beaucastel, Chateauneuf du Pape, Rhone, France 2009	175
<i>From one of the most highly established producers in the region and a warm vintage, full, rich yet balanced and ready to drink</i>	

Domaine de la Janasse, Chateauneuf-du-Pape Cuvee Chaupin, Rhone, France 2009 195
Full bodied, with silky tannins, a multi-dimensional, textured, voluptuous palate and a stunning finish, this wine is outrageously delicious and a phenomenal expression of grenache vines planted in 1912

NEBBIOLO & SANGIOVESE

Sangiovese, Ciacci Piccolomini d' Aragona, Rosso di Montalcino, Tuscany, Italy 2020 55
The wine has a dark ruby red colour. The aromas on the nose are fresh and fruity. A firm structure, that shows already great roundness that supports the alcohol content in perfect equilibrium

Sangiovese, Padelletti, Brunello di Montalcino, Tuscany, Italy 2012 140
From one of the oldest families in Montalcino, sweet plums and red cherries interlaced with appealing savoury notes. This has superb balance and style, with a finish that goes on and on

Nebbiolo, Prunotto, Barolo Bussia, Piedmont, Italy 2019 198
A slightly more modern expression of Barolo, darker fruit, lush with an earlier drinking window

Nebbiolo, Massolino, Barolo Riserva Vigna Rionda, Piedmont, Italy 2014 320
Massolino's Vigna Rionda is one of the best vineyards in Serralunga; a powerful, concentrated and mineral wine

Sangiovese, Biondi-Santi, Brunello di Montalcino, Tuscany, Italy 2009 345
A pioneer and iconic producer since the late 1800's; penetrating, savoury and sweet, with terrific energy and purity

TEMPRANILLO

La Piscina 'Crianza' Rioja, Spain 2018 58
While being a more traditional producer, their wines are not shy of density or fruit. Their crianza delivers an impressive core for the price

Marques de Murrieta, Reserva, Rioja, Spain 2017 78
Beautifully perfumed with dried flowers, violets and dark berries. Full bodied, yet refined with creamy, chewy tannins

Artadi, Pagos Viejos, Rioja, Spain 2010 185
Made from old-vine Tempranillo over 50 years old, it is aged in French oak unlike the more traditional aging in American oak. This is fleshy, vibrant wine that finishes with strong energy, supple tannins and superb persistence

MERLOT

Château Jacquet de la Grave, Bordeaux, France 2019 6 8 29
Fruit forward with a dash of earthiness. Fragrant with notes of plum, black cherries and tobacco

Blackbird 'Arise', Napa Valley, California, USA 2018 135
This classic Napa blend expresses luscious flavours that can only come from exceptional fruit

Château Cheval Blanc, Saint-Emilion, Bordeaux, France 2006 995
This warm and dry year was particularly favourable to Merlot. While it may not have the extraordinary concentration of 2005, 2006 Cheval Blanc is a rich, powerful wine with ripe fruit aromas and is already showing well

Château l'Evangile, Pomerol, Bordeaux, France 2010 650
Rich and full mouth feel with the velvety tannins imaginable

Petrus, Pomerol, Bordeaux, France 1986 5750
Petrus is Pomerol's most important wine. Medium to full bodied, velvety and rich, exceptional

Intense aromas of ripe fruit combined with floral and spicy hints. Round texture and soft tannins

A wine of great concentration, showing sweet and voluminous tannins and wonderful complexity
